The Problem

With today's growing demands for WiFi in schools, St Columb Minor faced a challenge to maintain its local popularity and reputation as a leader in education.

The school previously had in place Netgear access points where users struggled to maintain WiFi connectivity. This in turn limited the adoption of further digital technologies to progress teaching and learning. Staff also experienced WiFi 'deadspots' which inhibited the effective use of technologies during lessons and across the campus, whilst IT Technicians found WiFi management too complex and time consuming.



The Solution

St Columb Minor Academy turned to Ruckus Wireless and ICT specialist, NCI Technologies with the task of providing strong, stable and secure wireless coverage able to support more than 100 laptops, plus 140 mobile devices including iPAD mini's for pupils and teaching staff in a small area at once. Since the 'Blue School' was rolling out more and more tablet devices and laptops to pupils and staff, they needed a proactive company with responsive technical support.

As an accredited Ruckus Wireless Big Dog Partner, NCI Technologies performed a full site survey and spectrum analysis to detect interference and specified a ceiling mounted system with equipment list consisting of over 12 of the Zoneflex 7363 mid-range units with Ruckus' new BeamFlex+ Technology. The team also installed a gigabit Ethernet connection to power the network and enable the faster speed of around 700 MB. A feature-rich ZoneDirector controller was also installed to simply manage and coordinate the quantity of access points and support the multiple VLAN's. Coupled with NCI's professional installation and technical support, the solution provided was second to none.
